## “SECURITY AND HATE SPEECH”

PERSONAL SAFETY AND DATA SECURITY:  
RIGHTS IN THE AGE OF SOCIAL MEDIA

*Under the auspices of the Italian Presidency of the G7*

*Rome, September 14th, 2017*

The defence of personal rights against the risks of online data manipulation and the spread of hate speech and violence is the focus of the international conference among representatives of the legal professions of the Canada, France, Germany, Great Britain, Japan, United States and Italy, taking place at Palazzo della Cancelleria in Rome on September 14th, 2017 and promoted by the Consiglio Nazionale Forense under the auspices of the Italian Presidency of the G7.

The objective of this initiative is to strengthen a shared supranational strategy which – respecting the constitutional rights to free speech and privacy – protect personal dignity and security from false information and contrast discrimination based on race, religion or gender.

The event will also address the issue of education as a fundamental element in building a responsible global citizenship, sharing experiences of the G7 countries in strengthening values and skills in the age of digital communications technologies.

The initiative is connected with the theme of the Italian Presidency of the G7 - “Building the Foundations of Renewed Trust”- and falls within the goals of the UN 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, which promotes peaceful, inclusive societies, universal access to justice and defence of human rights.
